SUBJECT: REQUIRED TRAINING

1. While today's new members receive the majority of the required training, many members who have previously joined are lacking certain course completions. In an effort to insure all our members are properly training and briefed, and to continually monitor required training, unit commanders shall insure that members have completed the required post-Level I training prior to:
 - a. Participating any ES training - CPPT, OPSEC, EO, ORM
 - b. Promotion - CPPT, OPSEC, EO
 - c. Approval of any ES qualifications (initial or renewal) - CPPT, OPSEC, EO, ORM and safety training required for ES specialty
 - d. Validation of any ES or pilot qualification - CPPT, OPSEC, EO, ORM and safety training required for ES specialty or pilot qualification
 - e. Approval of any specialty track - CPPT, OPSEC, EO, ORM and safety training required for specialty track
 - f. Approval of any award or ribbon - CPPT, OPSEC, EO
 - g. Issuance of a CAP radio call sign - CPPT, OPSEC, EO, ORM and safety training required for radio operators
 - h. Issuance of any CAP asset - CPPT, OPSEC, EO
2. The required training includes but is not limited to:
 - a. CPPT
 - b. OPSEC
 - c. EO/Non-Discrimination (Initial and annual)
 - d. Safety Training (Basic or level required for position/specialty)
 - e. ORM (Basic or level required for position/specialty)
